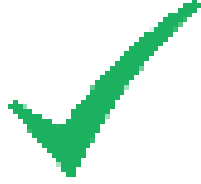

SOFT PLASTIC PACKAGING THAT CAN EASILY BE SCRUNCED INTO A BALL.

AS CLEAN & DRY AS POSSIBLE!

Biscuit packets (outer wrapper only)
Bread bags (without the tie or tag)
Bubble wrap (large sheets cut into A3 pieces)
Cellophane from bunches of flowers (cut into A3 pieces)
Cereal box liners
Chocolate and snack bar wrappers
Confectionery bags
Dry cleaning bags
Fresh produce bags
Frozen food bags
Ice cream wrappers
Large plastic sheets that wrap furniture (cut into A3 pieces)
Newspaper & magazine wrap
Pasta bags
Plastic Australia Post satchels
Plastic carrier bags from all stores
Plastic film wrap from grocery items such as nappies & toilet paper
Plastic sachets
Rice bags – both plastic & the woven type (cut into A3 pieces)
Snap lock bags / zip lock bags

NO HARD PLASTIC PACKAGING THAT KEEPS ITS STRUCTURE OR BOUNCES BACK WHEN YOU TRY SCRUNCHING IT

Plastic bottles e.g., milk bottles, soft drink, shampoo, sunscreen or sauce bottles, trigger packs
Plastic containers or tubs
Any rigid plastics such as meat trays, biscuit trays, or strawberry punnets
Aluminium lined bags e.g., pet food bags, chip packets
Aluminium cans
Adhesive tape
Agricultural films e.g., silage wrap, silage mesh, netting
Balloons of any kind
Bathroom/shower loofahs
Biodegradable/degradable/compostable/ plastics
Black plastic bags used to dispose of other soft plastics
Blister packs, tablets, and capsule packaging
Blow up pool, pool toys or beds – plastic or PVC
Bread bag tags or ties
Cat and dog food pouches – plastic or foil lined
Chip and cracker packets (silver lined)
Christmas tinsel and plastic Christmas trees
Cling wrap /film
Cooler bags
Disposable food handling gloves of any kind
Document sleeves
Drinking straws
Dry pet food bags
Drums e.g., chlorine or chemical drums

Film negatives and x-rays
Fishing
Food waste
Foam or polystyrene of any kind (including soft flexible foam)
Foil – Aluminium foil of any kind
Glass
Green bags / woven propylene bags
Laminated materials and overhead transparencies
Meat – plastic packaging that has contained meat
Medical waste materials
Multi-laminate films
Netting produce bags
Nylon – woven, soft or fishing line
Paper and cardboard
Paper post packs
Paper / clear vinyl packaging from sheets, doonas etc
Pet food bags (dog, cat, chaff, horse, chicken) - plastic, nylon, foil lined or woven polypropylene types
Plastic strapping used for securing boxes and pallets
Polyester of any kind
Potting mix and compost bags – plastic and woven polypropylene types
Powdered milk packets, made of foil
PVC or PVDC
Rope of any variety
Rubber, rubber gloves or latex
Solar pool covers
Squeeze pouches or lids e.g., yoghurt/baby food
Tarpaulins
Tetra packs e.g., milk cartons
Tin cans
VHS tape
Vinyl of any kind
Wet plastic material
Wine / water bladders – plastic or foil based
Wrapping paper and cardboard, ribbons or bows
Woven / polypropylene bags
