



### REPORT

#### BACKGROUND

As a part of the Northern Beaches Hospital Connectivity and Network Enhancement Project Roads and Maritime Services are proposing to install a refuge island on Frenchs Forest Road East, Frenchs Forest, near the existing right-angled parking bay and the shops. The proposed refuge island will improve safety of the pedestrians at this location.

#### LOCATION

- Frenchs Forest Road East is a state road (current classification) with a posted speed limit of 50km/h
- The section of the Frenchs Forest Road East under consideration has a pavement width approximately 12.5m
- There are a several shops and businesses at this section of the street
- There are 20 right-angled short-term parking spaces on the southern side of the street
- Allambie Grove Business Park and a childcare centre is near the subject location as well.

#### ISSUES

- There is currently no refuge island or marked pedestrian crossing linking the shops and parking spaces
- The nearby pedestrian signals require the use of two signalised legs to cross Frenchs Forest Road (East).

#### PROPOSAL

Council has undertaken a review of the location and issues and proposes to install a Refuge Island and two kerb ramps on either side of the refuge island.

#### PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLING IMPACT STATEMENT

This proposal will have the following impact(s) on pedestrians and people cycling:

- The proposal will improve the pedestrian facilities and increase the safety of the pedestrians as well.
- The proposal does not affect the people cycling along Frenchs Forest Road East.

## CONSULTATION

Roads and Maritime Services Northern Beaches Hospital Project Team have conducted public consultation and will conduct further consultation prior to construction once the Traffic Committee approves the proposal.
