LEGEND

- **PATHWAY NETWORK:**
Shared path network including appropriate road crossings to run from Narrabeen Lagoon; one leading to Dee Why and the other to Beacon Hill.
- **SECONDARY PATH:**
Develop new and up grade any current pathways which link to the shared pathway network system to provide access to and through the reserves.
- **GOLF CLUB PATHWAY:**
Cromer Golf Club to develop a shared pathway through the entire length of South Creek Foreshore as part of the main shared pathway network.
- **EXISTING PATHWAY:**
Existing concrete & bitumen paths to be retained or upgraded as part of the pathway network.
