# ACTIONS

## A. SIGNAGE

Signage is to provide comidor / reserve names & directional, compliance & interpretive information as required (Refer Action 31) Directional signage may include points of interest such as boardwalk crossings.

## B. BUSH RESTORATION & HABITAT PROTECTION

Expand the weed eradication & prevention program along Dee Why Creek & with the reserve (Refer Action 5).

Undertake an assessment of the reserve to identify potential new areas for bush & habitat restoration. Develop restoration plans for these new areas & any identified endangered communities & remnant habitat areas within the reserve. (Refer Action 2 & 3).

#### C. CREEK LINE

Improve & stabilise the creek as outlined in the *Fibodplain Risk Management Studies*. & Plans & the Warringah Creek Management Study: (Refer Action 7).

### D TRACKS & ACCESS

As part of the shared track network develop a pathway in Dumic Reserve to run through extent of reserve and connect to adjacent streets. St Matthews Farm, Cromer Park & Multi Use Access Path. (Refer Action 23).

## E. ENCROACHMENTS & RUBBISH DUMPING

Develop and implement a program to inform residents of the illegality & impact of dumping and encroachment on public land. This may include increased surveillance and relevant regulatory action. (Refer Action 18 & 53).

### F. PROPOSED BRIDGE / BOARDWALK CROSSING:

Where required, provide a boardwalk or bridge through wetland areas to improve crossing to enable safe pedestrian & cycle access. (Refer Action 30).

#### G. COMMUNITY USE

Develop a community space or picnic area considering the provision of furniture etc that will create a sense of character, improve safety, access & usability of the area (Refer Action 22).

#### H. ROAD CROSSING

Develop appropriate road crossings on Nth Fisher Rd to link proposed pathways & reserve (Refer Action 23).

#### I. 245 FISHER ROAD

245 Fisher Road is to be integrated into Dumic Place and developed into a community park as per Action 21.








# LOCALITY PLAN
