Part 1: Buy back of Interment Rights

<p>Sale of Unused Interment Right back to Council</p> <p>Council has a program to “buy back” unused Interment Rights at 50% of the current equivalent fee. Graves with monumental work or exhumed graves are not eligible. If you are not the interment rights holder you must first apply to transfer the interment rights. The following documents are required to finalise the buyback.</p> <p>Council buyback of unused Interment Right – When the applicant is the current Rights Holder*</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">Attach proof of purchase such as copy of certificate/ receipt if available, and complete Statutory Declaration on page 3.Complete the ATO “Statement by a Supplier” form on page 4 - note YOU are the supplier and the relevant reason for not quoting an ABN is “The supplier is an individual and has given the payer a written statement to the effect that the supply is wholly of a private or domestic nature from the supplier’s perspective”. Note this form is NOT sent to the Tax Office, it is kept in Council’s records for auditing requirements.Provide details for payment to your bank account via electronic funds transfer. <p>Council buyback of unused Interment Right – When the applicant is NOT the current Rights Holder</p> <p>If you are applying for a buyback of a grave, and you are not the Rights Holder, you must establish your claim to the burial rights first, by completing an “Application to transfer interment rights” - Form 4109.</p>

Statement by a supplier

Complete this statement if you:

Payers must withhold 46.5% of the total payment it makes to you for a supply that you make as part of your enterprise you carry on in Australia, unless an ABN has been quoted or there is no need to quote an ABN.

- The payer is not making the payment in the course of carrying on an enterprise in Australia.
The supplier is an individual aged under 18 years and the payment does not exceed \$120 a week.
The payment does not exceed \$75, excluding any goods and services tax (GST).
The supply that the payment relates to is wholly input taxed.
The supplier is an individual and has given the payer a written statement to the effect that the supply:
is made in the course or furtherance of an activity done as a private recreational pursuit or hobby, or
is wholly of a private or domestic nature (from the supplier's perspective).
The supply is made by an individual or partnership without a reasonable expectation of profit or gain.
The supplier is not entitled to an ABN as they are not carrying on an enterprise in Australia.
The whole of the payment is exempt income for the supplier.

Do not send this statement to the Tax Office. Give the completed statement to any payer that you are supplying goods or services to. The payer must keep this document with other records relating to the supply for 5 years.
